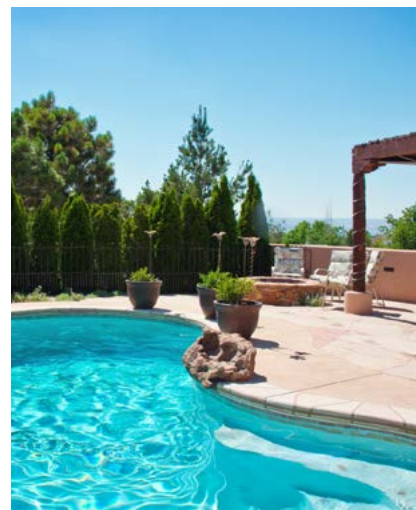

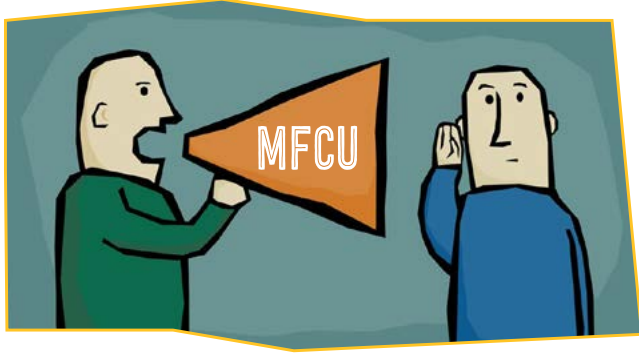

One position serving a three-year term is open for the MariSol Federal Credit Union's Board of Directors. Eligibility requirements are:

1. A director candidate must have served a minimum of one (1) year on a MariSol Federal Credit Union committee.

3. You must be 18 years of age.

## A Better, Safer Way to Transfer Funds

Zelle is a joint venture owned by multiple major banks, including Bank of America, Capital One, and Chase.

In 2023, Zelle faced over \$270 million in fraud that went unreimbursed, with the FTC reporting an 86% increase in scams on the platform.

**Starting March 31, 2025, unassociated debit cards, like MariSol's card, will no longer be accepted.**



### There are additional safer methods to transfer funds to or from a MariSol account:

- Venmo, CashApp, and PayPal: These options are similar to Zelle, offering fast transfers but with some risk. Accounts must be created on the provider app using your MariSol debit card number.
- A2A Transfers: Sign up to securely move money quickly between your MariSol account and your other accounts at U.S. banks and credit unions.
- Bill Pay: Pay one-time or recurring bills with ease.
- Wire Transfers – requires the transfer form to be completed in person at a MariSol branch.
